 - LEVEL 3 - for third graders who enjoy a wild challenge (Ages 8-9, Grades 2-4)
 - LEVEL 4 - for fourth graders and up who really know their stuff (Ages 9-10, Grades 3-5)
- **Compact packaging:** Perfect for classroom desktop use
- **Higher-level thinking and logic:** All the fun of trivia with an unconventional twist! Students will need to recognize the correct answer to provide the wrong answer
- **For one person or multiple players:** Can be used by a single student who finishes an assignment early, or as a class activity

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Activity Suggestions for

THAT'S RIGHT, THAT'S WRONG!

Give it a try! The worst you can be is right!

- **Customize it!** Make up your own trivia cards to integrate into the game. Include questions about your favorite things (foods, sports teams, colors, animals, etc.), your hobbies, and any other fun topics. Play with family members or friends to see how well you know one another!
- **Perfect for one player or many!** Try it on your own, or divide into teams!
- **How fast are you?** Try lightning **That's Right, That's Wrong!** See how many questions you can answer incorrectly in one minute.
- **A perfect game for "Opposite Day"!** Being WRONG is right.
- **Learn while having fun!** The cards provide the actual factual answers in addition to the WRONG answers. Encourage your students to learn more about the incorrect answers on some of the cards. For example, a card says, "Where will you be if you visit the Nutmeg State?" Connecticut or Florida are the choices. The back of the card says, "Wrong answer: Florida. (Connecticut is the Nutmeg State.)" Have your class find out Florida's nickname.
- **The options are endless!** Think of other ways to play the game, or to keep score.
