





Max wants to learn to draw like his friend Eugene, but he draws things in his own special style.


When he draws a horse, it looks like this.

HOW WOULD YOU DRAW A HORSE?












Max learns that sometimes it's helpful to follow the instructions, and sometimes it's fun to create from your own imagination. Now it's your turn! Draw a cat in the space below.

How to draw a cat










## CONNECT THE DOTS TO MAKE A SUPER COOL ANIMAL. CAN YOU GUESS WHAT IT IS?







## TIME FOR A DRAW-OFF!

Grab a friend and work together for this fun drawing activity!

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Parchment paper, or printer paper and tape
- Crayons, colored pencils, markers, etc.
- A friend to draw with
- A big imagination!

## INSTRUCTIONS:

- Step 1: Grab a big roll of parchment paper—don't worry, if you don't have parchment paper, you can tape five pieces of printer paper together!
- Step 2: Spread the paper out on the floor or a big table. Take a section on one end, and your friend can take a section on the other! Leave the section in the middle blank, for now.
- Step 3: Read your drawing prompt together: What animals do you think should be best friends, and what would they do if they spent the day together?
- Step 4: Start drawing your answer on your side of the paper! Your friend should start drawing on the other side. Let your imagination run wild!
- Step 5: Draw, doodle, and sketch all over, until your art and your friend's art are juuuuust about to meet in the middle of the paper.
- Step 6: Now you get to draw together! Combine both of your art styles in the middle section and "turn up the AWESOME!" What are your animals going to do now that they're together?
- Step 7: Enjoy your AMAZING joint creation!!
