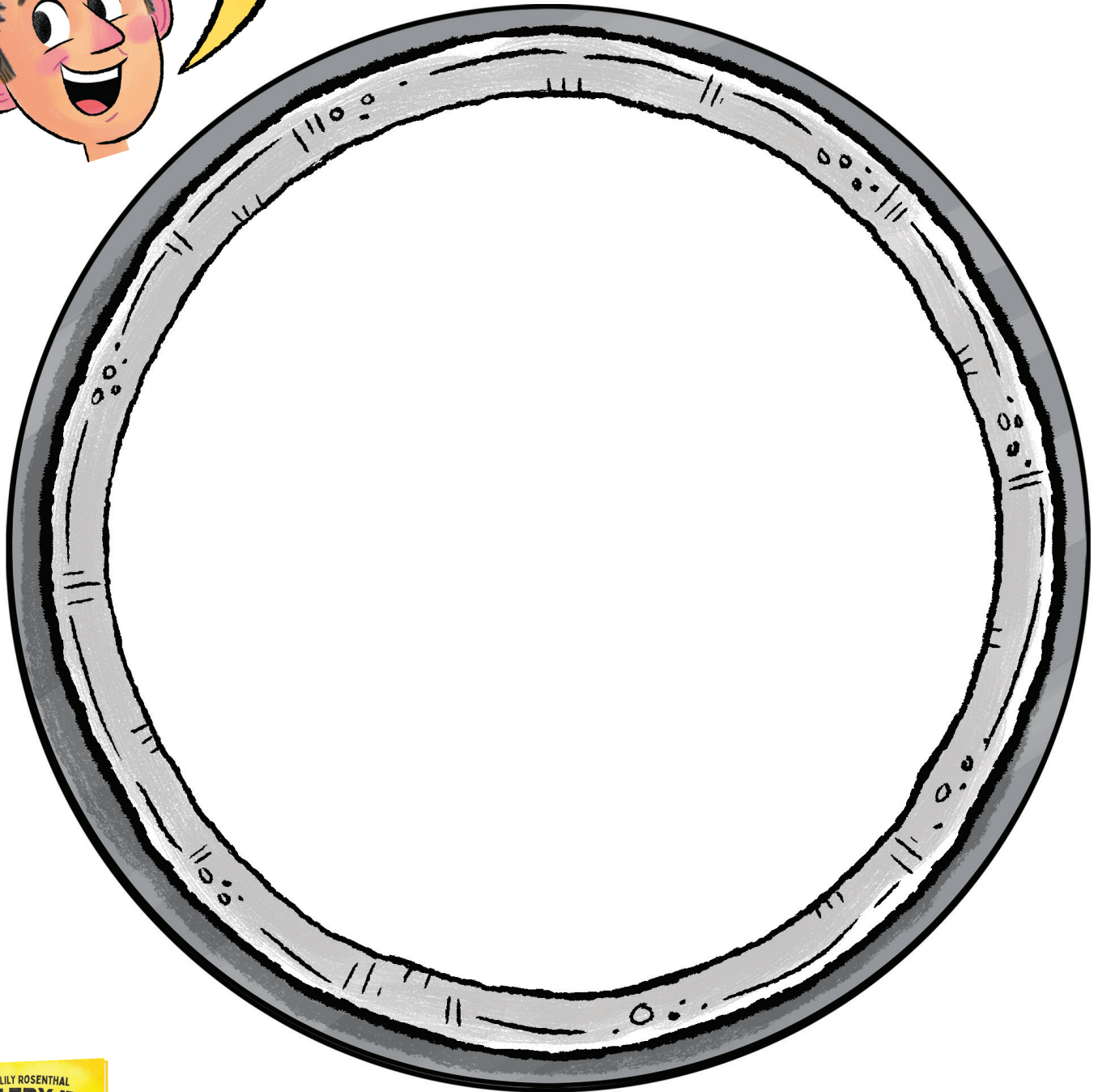


MY FANTASY PIZZA

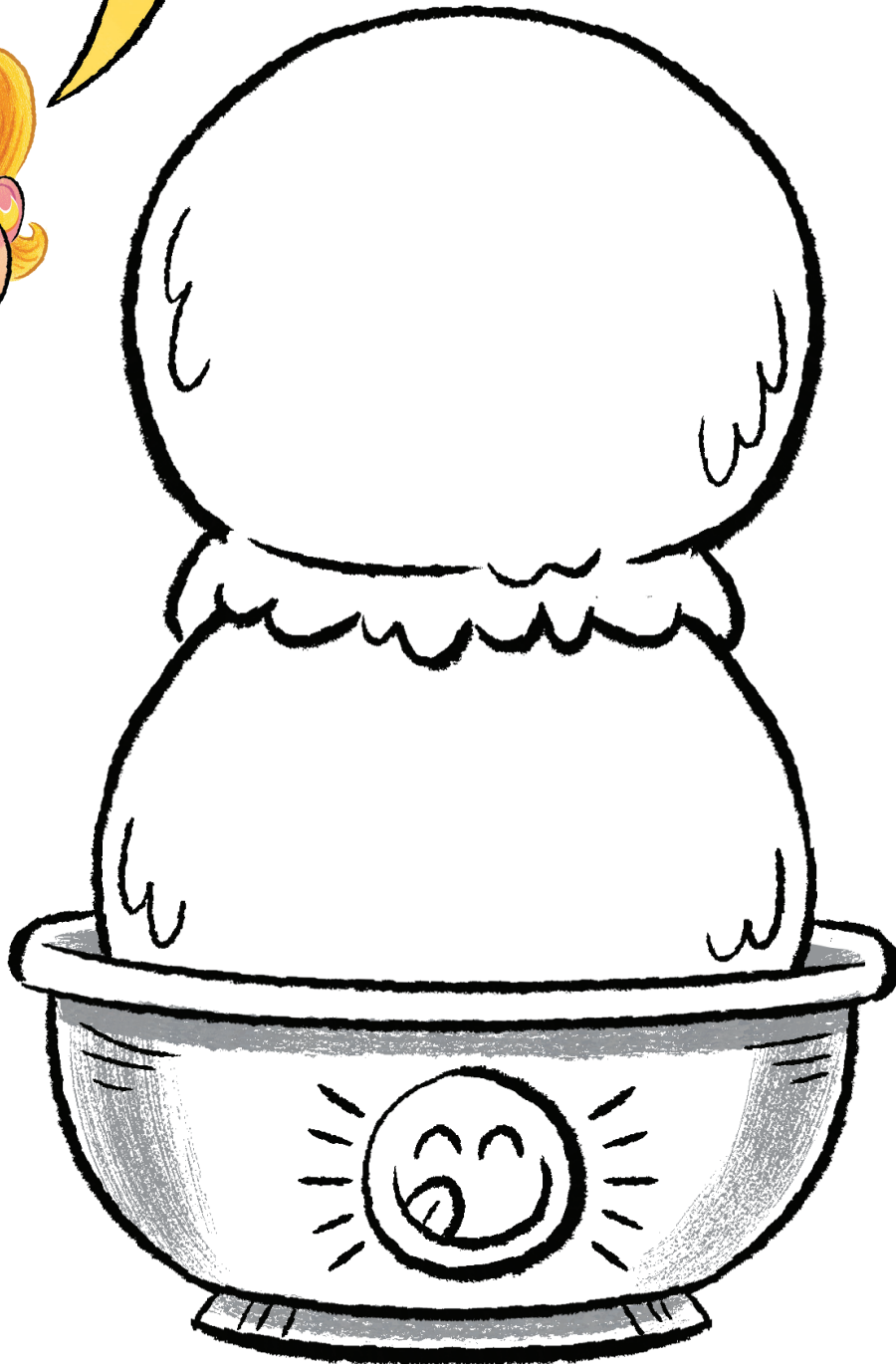
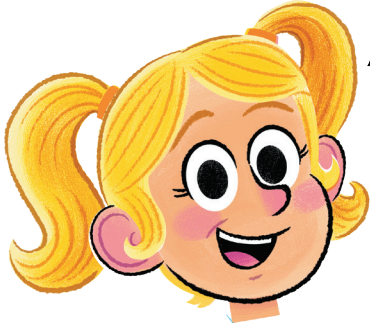
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MY FANTASY ICE CREAM

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DIY PAPER CHEF HAT

If you had access to all the ingredients in the world, what type of unique dishes would you put together for your family and friends to taste test? Put on your chef hat and let's get cooking!

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Glue or tape the two sheets of paper together.
2. Turn the two sheets of paper around so you're on the back side to start decorating! Make sure it's right side up. (Hint: the *Just Try It!* logo will tell you if you're upside down.) Don't forget to add in your name, chef!
3. When you're done decorating, turn the two sheets of paper around again and cut along the dotted lines. (Ask a grown-up for help if you need it!)
4. Glue or tape the top gray section to the bottom gray section.
5. Time to check! The "flaps" you've created should be at the top, and the *Just Try It!* logo should be on the bottom left.
6. Cut along the dotted line on the bottom right, removing one of the "flaps."
7. Glue or tape gray box #1 (back) on top of gray box #2, and there you have it—your own chef hat!

Note: If you find the chef hat is too small, you may need an additional "LEFT" sheet (page 3). After printing: cut along the dotted lines, glue or tape the top gray section to the bottom gray section, and attach it to gray box #2 and remove "flaps" as needed to adjust for sizing.
