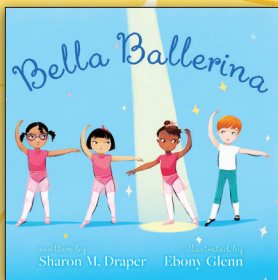

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A Crown of Stars

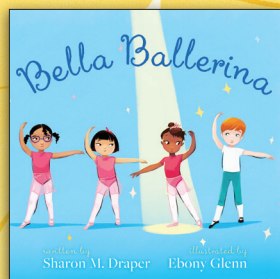


Even if you're shy there's no need to hide—take a leap of faith and make your very own crown! Once you're finished, try creating a fun dance like Bella and her friends.

Directions:

1. With an adult's help, use scissors to cut out the crown and rectangular pieces.
2. Color in your dancing crown!
3. Then, tape or glue the two rectangular pieces together.
4. Measure the rectangular strip around your head and using a pencil, mark where your crown will end.
5. Color in the headband of your crown!
6. Once you are finished coloring your crown and its headband, tape or glue the ends of your headband together. Then, glue your crown piece in the center.
7. Put your beautiful crown on and get ready to chassé, passé, and prance!

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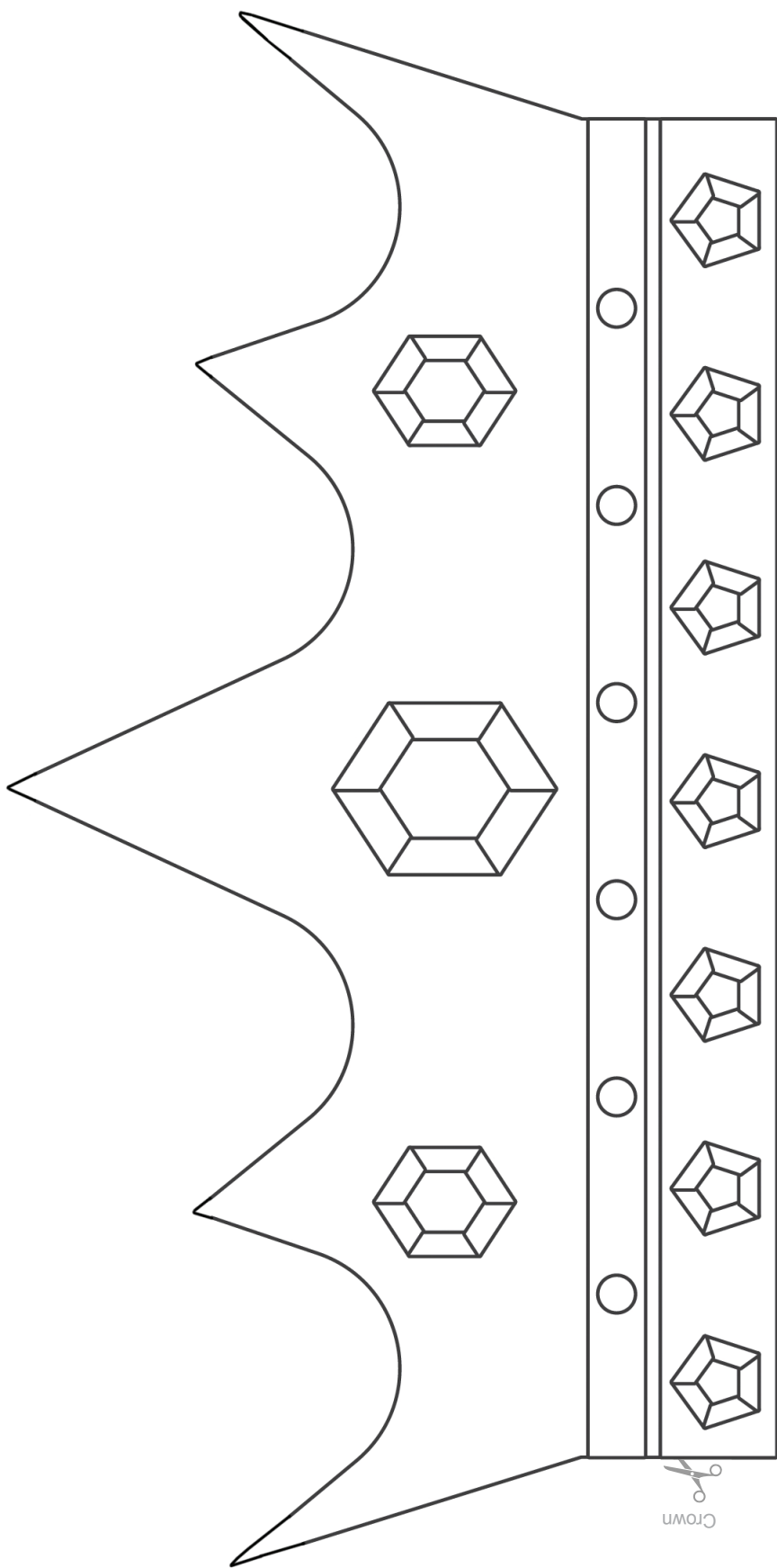
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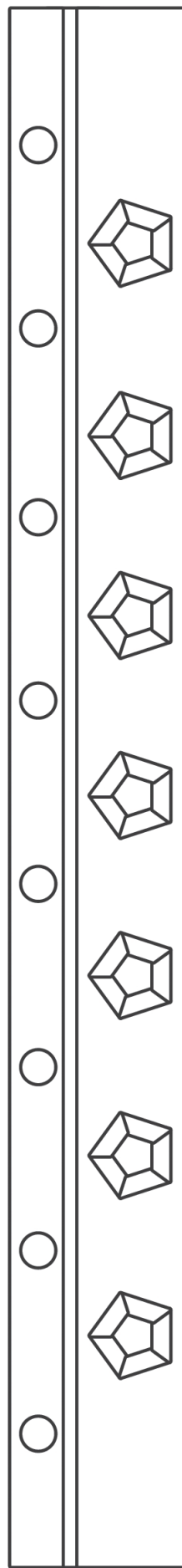


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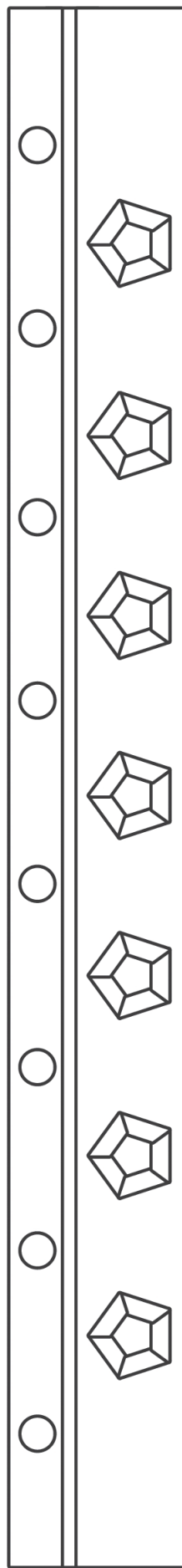
