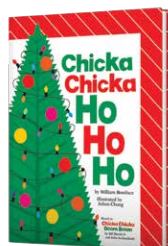
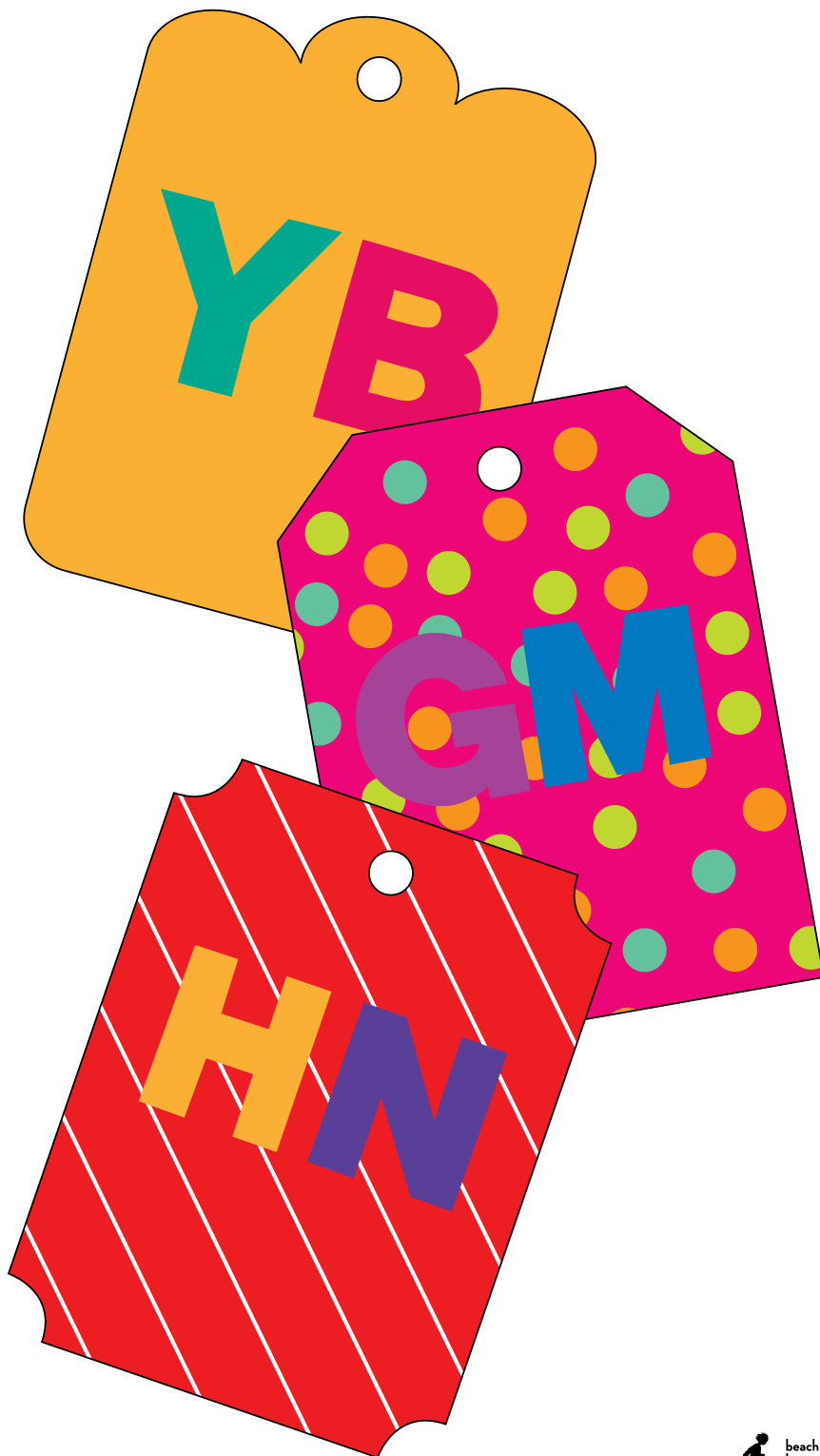


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The Season of Giving!

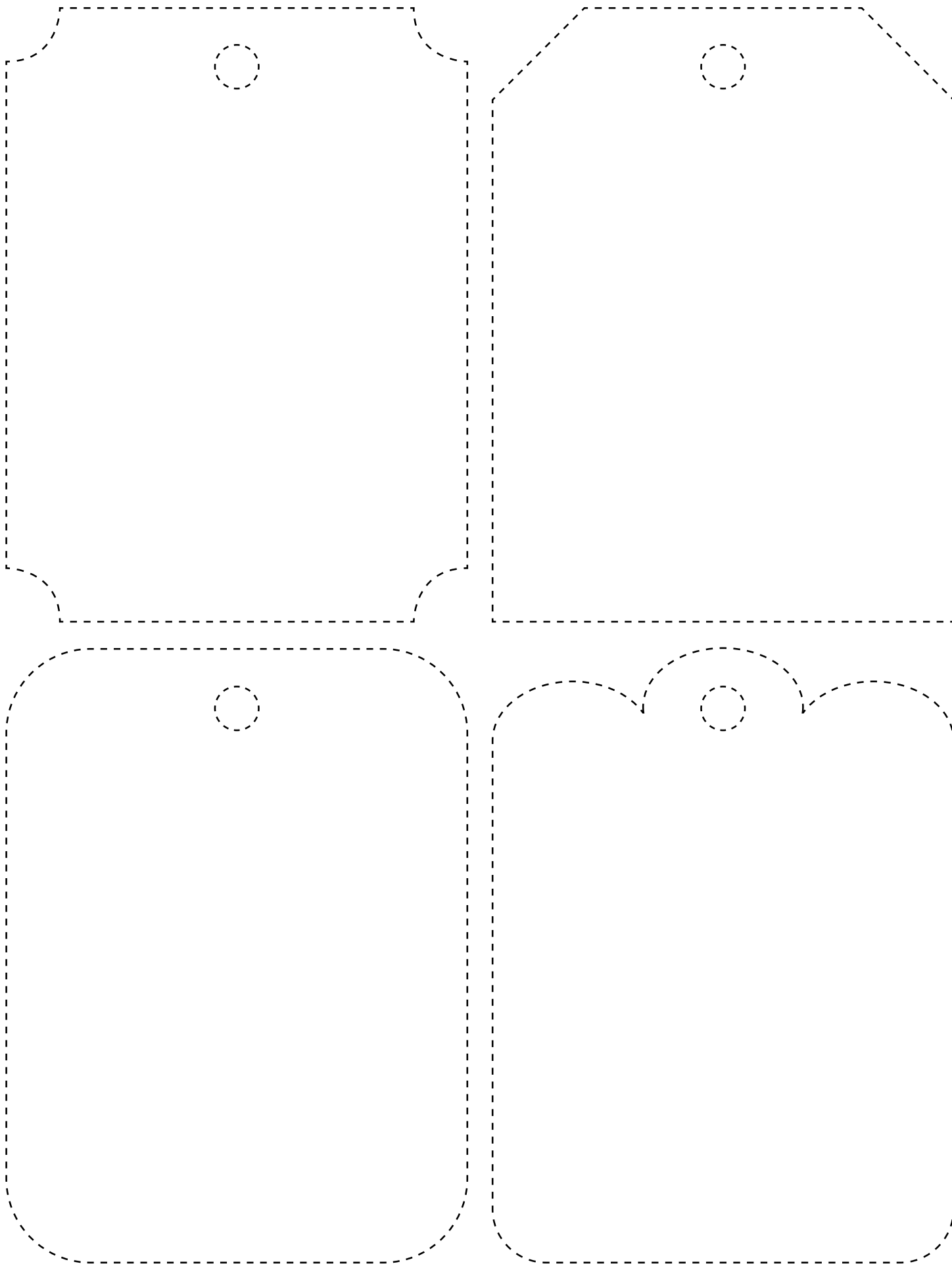
One of the best ways to spread joy and love is by giving a thoughtful gift. Follow the instructions below to make your own Chicka Chicka gift tag!
