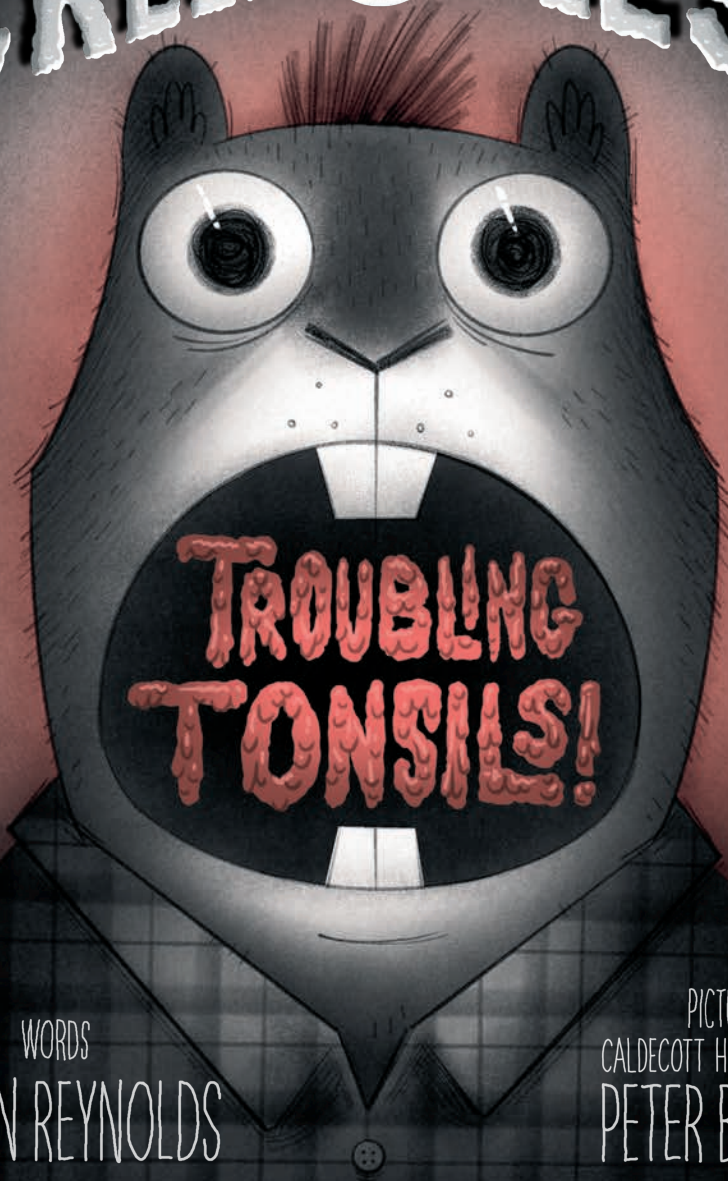

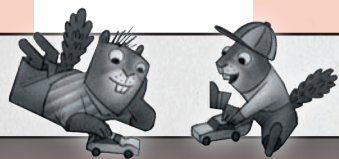
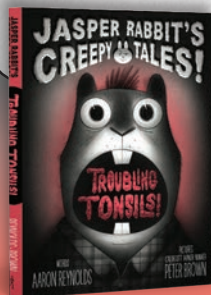
Curious on where to start with a story?

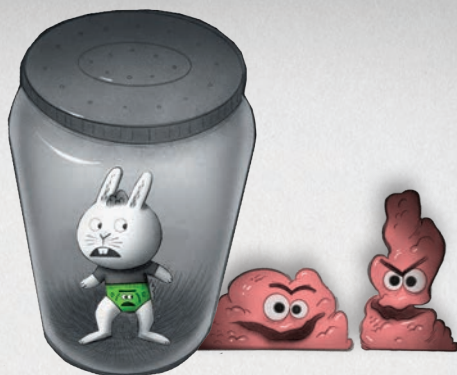

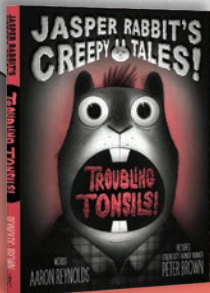

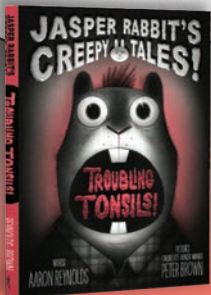
