





Oh, no! The spaceship is broken. Cut out the pieces. Use tape or glue to build the spaceship on the next page.





Color and cut out Boo. Bend his arms forward.





Draw a picture of your boo in the red and blue frame.

Cut out your picture. Use tape, glue, or staples to attach it to Boo's paws (from the previous page). Give it to your boo.








Boo used letters to spell the word 'CAT' on his tub. Can you find it? Circle it.
