



Play Opposites with Rosie

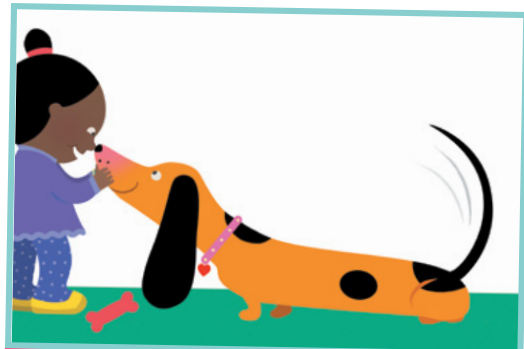

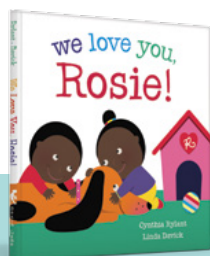
