You Can Make Cookies To Share!

Here is one of the Dungy family's favorite cookie recipes. It's a recipe they love to share with their friends (like you!), and they hope you'll share it with your friends, too. Enjoy!

With the help of a parent or guardian, you can make the Dungy family cookie recipe.

OATMEAL CHOCOLATE CHIP COOKIES

1 CUP BUTTER
1 CUP BROWN SUGAR
1 CUP WHITE SUGAR
½ t BAKING POWDER
3 EGGS (BEATEN)
2 t VANILLA
½ CUP MILK
2 CUPS FLOUR

1 t BAKING SODA
¼ - ½ t CINNAMON
½ t BAKING POWDER
1 - 2 CUPS OATMEAL
1 CUP CORNFLAKES
2 PKS CHOCOLATE CHIPS (MINI)
1 CUP PECANS (OPTIONAL)

CREAM BUTTER AND SUGARS, THEN ADD EGGS, VANILLA, AND MILK. SIFT DRY INGREDIENTS – ADD TO CREAMED MIXTURE. ADD CORNFLAKES, OATMEAL, NUTS, AND CHIPS. ROLL INTO SMALL BALLS. PLACE IN PRE-HEATED OVEN (350 DEGREES). BAKE 10–15 MINUTES.
